COLD SEASON

Cold weather can be especially risky for older adults, so taking a few simple precautions can make a big difference. Here are some practical, ways to help keep the geriatric population warm and safe:

- *Maintain indoor temperatures at a safe level
- *Use layered clothing, warm socks, blankets, and draft blockers around doors/windows.
- *Add hats, gloves, scarves, and warm, non-slip boots when going outside.
- *Check that carbon monoxide and smoke detectors are working if heating devices are in use.
- *Regular check-ins (in person or by phone) to help ensure they're warm, safe, and have what they need when at home.
